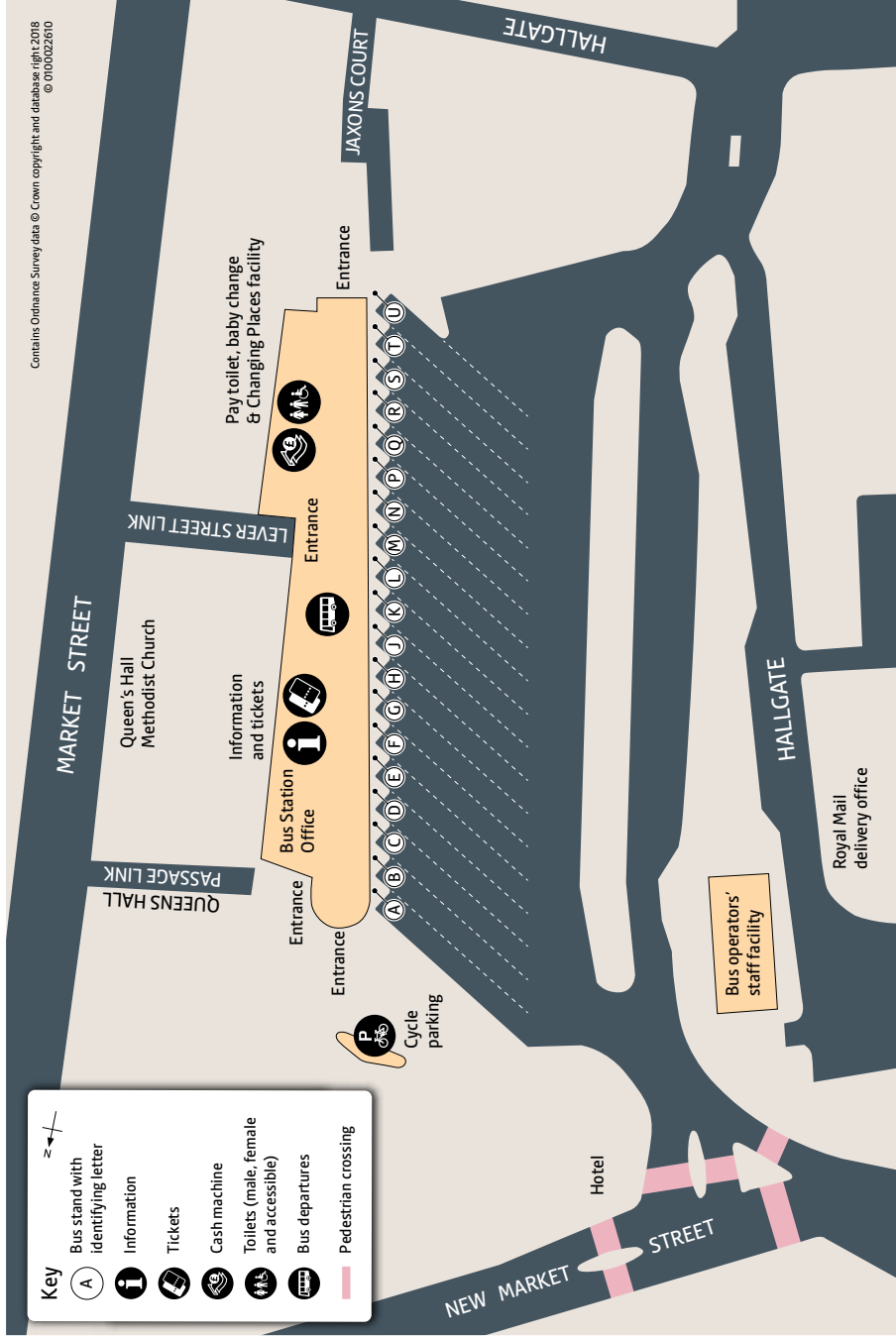




# The new Wigan Bus Station will open from 8am on Sunday 28 October
